Spotlight UK have applied for the sum of £1000 towards the cost of holding an Adventure Play project for young people in Andover. This project will be held at Andover Leisure Centre for 10 weeks and will benefit children suffering from long term mental or physical illness, who are young carers, children living with a terminally ill family member, who suffer from abuse or neglect, have suffered trauma or living with someone with a drug or alcohol problem.

Spotlight UK provide fun, safe and enjoyable spaces for young people to have positive interactions with others and make happy memories. The schools Spotlight UK work with locally for this project are Knights Enham, Portway Infants and Juniors and Romans Way. The schools involved also fundraise as well as using the services provided by Spotlight UK. The Adventure Play project will begin in September and run weekly, benefitting 400 children.

Approximate Number of young people who will benefit in Andover: 400

How will this event benefit people in Andover: Spotlight UK act as a resource for children locally by providing advice, emotional support and programmes of physical, education and other activities as a means of helping these young people. They are able to develop their skills, capabilities and capacity to participate in society. Spotlight UK aims to improve young people's condition in life and in hosting events like Adventure Play these children get respite from their daily challenges and are able to just enjoy being a child.

In answer to questions raised by the C&E Working Group: Spotlight have received funding which is currently restricted for other projects in other areas. This is seen in the bank as Spotlight UK work across Hampshire and Berkshire. Consequently, Spotlight UK are applying for further funding for this project, which is local to Andover, despite there being funds in the bank.

Spotlight UK have also secured funding from the Cost-of-Living fund for activities for children in Andover C of E Primary & Vigo Primary. They have also secured funding via the Millway ward for children's activities for children of the Balksbury Federation & St John Baptiste school.
