Bringing Andover Together CIC have applied for £650 towards the cost of Test Valley Young Entrepreneurs Contest which will take place in February 2024. This contest is looking for the next business leader of Test Valley, an 11–18-year-old with an idea to change the game, start a brand-new business and inspire other young people. Last year, this scheme saw 3 young people receive mentorship from local businesses and has even seen one of the schemes successful young Entrepreneurs aspire to open a Cat Café in Andover town centre. Test Valley Young Entrepreneurs Contest 2024 will take place in February 2024, the lead up to this event will begin in October 2023. The project scope has been included in the Application pack for Councillors to view.

Approximate Number of young people who will benefit in Andover: 150

How will this event benefit people in Andover: This event will enable the young people from across the Borough to discover their own entrepreneurial spirits and identify key young people who are showing the most determination to become future leaders within the Borough. It will encourage positive business ties and grow young people's interpersonal skills, readying them for the world of business and the workplace.

Key Organisations in Andover are involved in this scheme, such as Test Valley Borough Council, Hampshire County Council, Hampshire Chamber of Commerce, the Andover BID, Andover & Romsey networking groups, local businesses and key stake holders from across the Borough.

This year's contest has a big focus on volunteering and work experience as part of the project, there will be encouragement to better our community and to create and improve opportunities for local young people. The young people involved in the contest will be supporting other young people within Andover to help encourage the next generation of leaders realise their potential.
