Installation Update:

Christmas Tree fencing; was delivered and installed successfully at 4.30pm on Thursday 9th November, in attendance Tor Warburton, Deputy Clerk.

Christmas Lights: Were successfully installed on the night of Sunday 12th November – in attendance Tor Warburton, Deputy Clerk (from midnight Micha Young, Committee Officer) Cllrs T Reynolds, R Hughes and J Hughes. The installation continued the following day with Tor Warburton, Deputy Clerk and Cllrs J Cockaday and J Hughes in attendance.

Christmas Lights extension.


The extension has now been mapped on Parish online and all of the available/approved columns are marked on the attached map.

Of the available columns the recommended ones are the central ones in both car parks (Black Swan Yard and George Yard) and Waterloo Court going towards the Town Mills pocket park. This will provide a consistent expansion to the lights which will bring together the High Street and the immediate surrounding areas.

This will increase the Christmas Lights provision by 20 columns at an indicative cost of £6,080 (costs based on £304 per column quoted in January 2023). Money was agreed to be taken from CiL funds.


Recommendations:
