What evidence of need for the project, activity, event, equipment or service can you provide us with?  Full Council meeting	20th Andover Guides are planning a residential to Northern Ireland from 10- 15 April 2025.  We will be staying at Lorne Estate owned and operated by Girlguiding Ulster. We are acutely aware of the impact of the cost-of-living crisis for our Guides families, and as such residential events we offer the Guides are usually capped at around £100. On this basis we realised this trip would be a significant financial cost for our families (at £500 per person), given the price of the flights alone. However, we know this will be a once in their lifetime trip for many of our Guides. Leaders attending the trip are paying the same as the Guides to participate, despite already volunteering time (and annual leave from work) to make it happen. We have therefore been committed to supporting them fundraising to reduce the cost of this trip. We have been and continue to organise opportunities for this, for example recently they have been undertaking several community-based activities such as marshalling at local running events in return for donations to support the costs.  Residential events provided by Girlguiding are a unique opportunity to give girls an amazing experience. It's important for our members to develop their independence and our residential experiences crucially								iding risis for Guides s trip his will ite, to ng hd they as pport			

Total project amount	provide this. Unlike schools where these experiences tend to be age based, due to our 10-14 age range we cross primary and secondary schools, meaning our Guides mix within ages. This boosts the confidence of our younger members and develops the leadership skills of our older ones. In addition, this trip is a unique experience for our members. Being based in a military area, with many of our girls' families having military links - the history with The Troubles and Northern Ireland's relationship with the United Kingdom is an important part of the history of this company for our Guides to learn about.
