Dear Micha,

Thank you for your email regarding TPO tree works applications. In answer to point one, unfortunately, we cannot insist on photographs to be attached to applications. I do agree that some of the sketch plans are not of good quality but generally are sufficient for the tree officer to locate the tree when undertaking a site visit/assessment.

The number in brackets are not really relevant to the application. In some cases, the applicant has an individual number tag on their trees to assist in the tree's identification for survey purposes and it does help tree officer to locate the tree when on site.

All that is required by the legislation is that the tree is given a number i.e. T1, T2, etc and that the species, if known by the applicant, is also provided within the application.
