Subject: Notification of Village Green 280 - Ladies Walk - Andover

I'm writing with regard to an application to register land at Ladies Walk, Andover as a village green (see attached notice, also available for viewing online at [COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15\(1\) NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE REGISTRATION OF LAND AS A TOWN OR VILLAGE GREEN LADIES WALK DOWN \(EAST\), ANDOVER – VG280 | Hampshire County Council](#) which has been taken up for investigation. The consultation period for the application will run for a period of six weeks from 22.08.2025. During the six week consultation period, any owner, lessee, tenant or occupier, or any other interested party can object to the application. Once the consultation period closes the County Council will consider all representations, and in due course, determine whether or not to register the land. If Test Valley Borough Council or Andover Town Council wishes to make any representations it is very welcome to do so.

[The Commons \(Registration of Town or Village Greens\) \(Interim Arrangements\) \(England\) Regulations 2007](#) requires that copies of the attached notice and the application itself is served upon every concerned authority for the area. Section 5(3) states that:

(3) Every concerned authority receiving under this regulation a notice and a copy of an application must—

(a) immediately display copies of the notice; and

(b) keep the copy of the application available for public inspection at all reasonable times until informed by the registration authority of the disposal of the application.

If you could therefore make arrangements to keep copies of the notice and plan on display at the offices of Test Valley Borough Council and make a copy of the application available to anyone who requests it (until the matter is determined), I would be grateful.

I will revert back to you once the consultation period has expired.
