Proposed by **Councillor R Hughes** and seconded by **Councillor L Gregori** "That Andover Town Council rejects the proposals advanced by Hampshire County Council and East Hampshire Local Authority.

Signed as a true and accurate record of the meeting

That Andover Town Council supports Option 1 from the documents, "Close enough to be local big enough to stay strong", produced by 12 of the 15 local authorities in Hampshire and the Isle of Wight. Reinforced by the document produced by Test Valley Borough Council, "The Power of Place: A Transformative Vision for Local Government in Hampshire and the Solent." A proposal to establish a new Mid Hampshire unitary authority encompassing the existing footprints of New Forest District Council, Test Valley Borough Council, Winchester City Council and East Hampshire District Council. That Andover Town Council does not support Option 2 or Option 3.

Andover Town Council firmly resolves that if Option 1 is rejected – and any alternative proposals involve splitting Test Valley's existing boundaries or subsuming Andover into a Greater Southampton arrangement – then residents must be fully and properly consulted. Any attempt to redraw boundaries without meaningful public input would be unacceptable.
