Next steps

The responses gathered through the consultation will be submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for scrutiny, together with the Submission version of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan 2040. This is intended for July 2024, subject to any necessary democratic approvals.

Having considered the consultation responses, a Planning Inspector will determine whether further changes need to be made to the Plan before it is "sound" (i.e. it complies with national policy and legal requirements) and can be adopted by the five authorities.











Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan: Partial Update

Notice of Regulation 19 Public Consultation and Statement of Representations Procedure

Hampshire County Council, New Forest National Park Authority, Portsmouth City Council, South Downs National Park Authority & Southampton City Council are working to produce a partial update to the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan (the 'Plan') which will guide minerals and waste decision making in the Plan Area (covering all of their respective areas and those parts of the South Downs which fall within Hampshire) up until 2040.

The Proposed Submission draft of the Plan is being published in accordance with Regulation

19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 for representations to be made on the 'soundness' and legal compliance of the plan (and its accompanying material). The representations will be compiled and submitted to the Secretaryof State for independent examination. Representations must refer to the tests of 'soundness' and include a name and address. They may include a request to be notified when the Plan is submitted for independent examination, when the examination recommendations are published and/or when the Plan has been adopted.



• Waiting restriction sign post, west of number 55, opposite lamp column 3 (in between junctions of St John's Road and Silkweavers Road)

Except for parked vehicles, good visibility to both west and east, but maybe too close to the roundabout.
