The proposed shopfront, due to its design, appearance and detailing, would be harmful to the significance of the Non-Designated Heritage Asset, as it would fail to respect the historical character of the building and the locality, particularly due to the flat design of the shopfront. It would also be harmful to the setting of 10A Bridge Street, which is viewed as part of a pair with 8 Bridge Street, as it fails to integrate with the historical design of the adjacent building, which has a recessed door, bay windows, low stall risers, a narrow fascia board and cornice detailing. The large fascia of the application site, which impinges upon the first floor level of the building, is not in proportion to the shopfront, and would dominate the front elevation of the building. The proposed shopfront would therefore be unduly prominent within the street scene and would not integrate with or respect the historical character of the area and the primary shopping frontage. The proposal is therefore contrary to Policies COM2, E1 and E9 of the Test Valley Borough Revised Local Plan (2016), the Andover Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan (2021) and the Shopfront Design Guide (2010).

## **Test Valley Borough Council 2022 Strategic Housing & Economic Land Availability Assessment (SHELAA) and Green Land Availability Assessment (GLAA) – Call for Sites**

Test Valley Borough Council is issuing a Call for Sites as part of its Strategic Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment (SHELAA) and Green Land Availability Assessment (GLAA).

As a requirement of the National Planning Policy Framework, the SHELAA is a technical document which provides information on sites for potential housing, economic development, Gypsy and Travelling Showpeople, Self-Build housing etc. in relation to their suitability, availability and achievability.

The GLAA allows the Council to continue to promote the conservation, restoration and enhancement of priority habitats and identify and pursue opportunities for securing measurable net gains for biodiversity in line with National Planning Policy among other ecological benefits.

The Council is undertaking this exercise in order to help inform future planning processes and will contribute to the preparation of the draft Local Plan 2040 for the Borough.

This is an opportunity for land owners to promote any new sites for consideration. This is not a review of existing SHELAA and GLAA sites, therefore there is no requirement to resubmit current sites. However, it is an opportunity to submit any further evidence or updated information of current SHELAA sites for consideration.

**The inclusion of a site in the SHELAA or GLAA does not allocate a site or imply that the Council would necessarily grant planning permission.**

All promoted sites will be made publicly available. Individual personal details and land ownership details will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

**With regards to residential and economic uses, the Council will accept sites for a net gain of 5 or more dwellings and sites that are 0.25ha (or likely to provide at least 500m<sup>2</sup> of economic floor space) and above.**
