This is one of several new businesses opening in the Andover Town area, which is very welcome to see. • On 9th March, I attended, along with Councillors Bird, Burley, Cockaday, Farren and Meyer, the Commonwealth Affirmation prior to the Commonwealth flag being raised at 10am on the Guildhall. C434/03/26	<p>Councillor M Farren I am gathering more information regarding the lack of bus routes within Andover and will be approaching TVBC and HCC about it.</p>
C435/03/26	<p>Councillor G Walters There is another Vigo Park progress drop-in session in the former O2 shop, Chantry Centre, on Saturday 14th March 2026, from 10.00am to 3.00pm. I’m skeptical but impressed and it will be a great amenity for the town.</p>
C436/03/26	<p>Councillor S Hardstaff Further to the debacle over the ownership of footpaths between Lillywhite Crescent and Witan Close, which floods every year and becomes impassable. Each year, I have to contact someone to come and dig out and clear the path, as it effectively turns into a moat. After around six months of trying to establish responsibility, I have finally been informed that Hampshire County Council (HCC) manage the footpath itself, whilst Test Valley Borough Council (TVBC) manage the banks. However, neither authority is currently taking full responsibility for resolving the issue. In order for HCC to rectify the problem, the path would need to be raised above the level of the banks on either side. Fortunately, Kit Malthouse MP has now stepped in to support this matter and is working to get TVBC to dig two trenches either side of</p>

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	<p>the footpath to improve drainage. However, these trenches are likely to fill in again each year, so a longer-term roadmap is needed.</p> <p>I wanted to share my frustration, as this reflects the experience residents must face when trying to establish who is responsible for different areas. It has taken six months for someone to confirm ownership, which is clearly not acceptable.</p>
