- **The planning application does not contain any information from Southern Water regarding the proposed sewage effluent drainage arrangements, which is concerning.**
- **Unclear details regarding the supply of water from Southern Water.**
- **No provision of social housing.**
- **Not in keeping with the surrounding area.**
- **No additional information from the Integrated Care Board (ICB)**
