PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

PC 035/07/23 Member of the Public 1:

I object to the planning application 23/01616/FULLN, on 2 grounds. The volume of traffic will further increase during construction and after completion. The nature of the character of the Picket Piece village is changing with these little packets of buildings.

PC 036/07/23 Member of the Public 2:

I object to planning application 23/01616/FULLN also, based on the increase in traffic volume, disruption during the construction phase and after completion. The quality of the build and necessity is questioned. I understand Test Valley Borough Council had fulfilled its obligation as far as the 25-year plan was concerned. There is no infrastructure to support it, from the point of view of health support and schools.

PC 037/07/23 Member of Public 3:

Regarding Item 7, I would like to applaud this administration and its approach to working with Members of the Public. I am referring to the Community & Events Panel and I am pleased to see point 3 of your draft Terms of Reference, proposing to co-opt Members of the Public on this committee. Can I ask, is this co-option at each meeting or are you looking to co-opt yearly or for current term? If you adopt the draft version, I would be pleased to offer my knowledge and experience to this committee, as I was the Vice Chairman of the Northern Area Planning Committee on the Borough.

PC 038/07/23 Member of Public 4:

The planning application for Picket Piece will further exasperate problems with accidents due to increases in traffic volume. Some areas are unpaved with children and parents needing to walk across the roundabouts. There are many blind spots there, which causes concerns for safety.

PC 039/07/23 Member of Public 5:

My views are the same regarding increase in traffic in the mornings and speed they go through there. To have more traffic coming out of that area will be a big problem and that is where the school children collect the school bus from. Is the proposed entrance going to be the only one? There are no road safety provisions.

Objection:

- Massive concerns relating to increase in traffic volume and speed during and after construction.
- Concerns over safety of residents, particularly parents and school children crossing in the proposed site, due
- to no provision of pavements. This should be provided in the interest of health & safety.
- Road safety issues including blind turns and cycle paths provision.
- The plans are unclear as to the number of potential entrances and exits from the new dwelling.
- Overdevelopment of the site.
- Not in keeping with the local area.
- No infrastructure, i.e. health clinics or schools

- Nitrate Neutrality has not been addressed.
- No details on future proofing, i.e., provision of green spaces, electric charging points, heat pumps or solar panels.
- Lack of information on the environmental impact.
- TVBC Local Plan stated 400 new houses to be built in Picket Piece, this has already been exceeded in Locksbridge Road.

A resident of Picket Piece added a comment that the paths were inadequate.
